1. Apologies

Apologies for absence were received from Leigh-Ann Medhurst.

2. Declaration of Interest for items on the agenda

Stuart Ward declared an interest in item 4a(i) as his company was the applicant. The Clerk advised him that he could answer questions regarding the application but should then move to the public area while the item was debated.

3. Public Forum

A member of the public adjoining the applicant site stated that they were not happy with the proposed size of the structure in the middle plot and felt that this was not in keeping with the rural location. It was felt that a chalet bungalow would be more appropriate. In response, Stuart Ward noted that the Broads Authority would not allow bungalows due to flood risk. The member of the public went on to note that Croft Hill had uninterrupted views which would be impacted by this development.

4. Planning

BA/2021/0181/FUL Land Adjoining Tiedam, Mill Road, Stokesby: Residential development of 2no semi-detached townhouses and 2no. detached houses

It was noted that in the original application the Parish Council had stated that they would prefer to see bungalows on the site. It was noted that Croft Hill was not in a flood risk area. It was **agreed** to respond stating that the Council did not object to the development but would like to see Plot 3 reduced in height to a chalet bungalow over to the oversized nature of the existing proposal, proposed by Rob Lloyd, seconded by Ed Wharton, 5 in favour, 1 abstention.
